5606 Pair 'Darkly' Mirrors Designed by Stockholm-based Nick Ross for MENU 2013

\$5,500/pair; each of brushed solid brass with a clean and simple cup-shaped design; no longer in production; some patina and rubbing to frames and mirror plates The Darkly Mirror is an exploration of the history of human beings' relationship with the reflected image. Historians believe that the earliest mirrors may have been small ceramic bowls filled with water used during the late Stone Age. Although not proven, this notion fascinated Stockholm-based designer Nick Ross, whose Darkly Mirror for MENU takes inspiration from the ceramic bowls. "That it cannot be proven adds to the object's mystery. Is this a new object, or an old one reinvented? I wanted to take this notion and create a modern object which questioned its possible past and its relation to 'the self'."
