Large ceramic vessel with cerulean blue crackle glaze overlay with vertical optical stripes designed and manufactured by Jaru of Southern California circa 1950s; tall and sculptural having a long flaring neck above a bulbous body; a rare and uncommon Jaru large scale production; maker's label to underside; good vintage condition with no chips or cracks; overall light wear; wear to underside with original felt pad Jaru Art Products began in 1950 by Jack and Ruth Hirsh in Culver City, California. The name is a combination of the first two letters of their first names (Ja and ru). Jaru sold artwares by various artists then later created its own line. Most pieces were marked with a simple paper sticker, although some have an impressed mark. Jaru was sold in 1968
